Postgraduate Certificate in Special Educational Needs

Duration: Normally 1 year Part time

Total credit rating: 60

Most students will start the programme in the Autumn Term, initially completing a Post-Graduate Certificate in one academic year. After successful completion of a PGCert, students may continue to study for the MA Education. Students have up to five years to complete the MA Education. Module delivery will normally be within a school's half-year of c. 19 weeks, with most sessions running fortnightly as 'twilight' sessions. Occasional Saturday sessions will be timetabled as appropriate.
