

Changes to your course for Academic Year 2020/2021 due to COVID-19:

Professional Practice in Management and Leadership (Degree Level Apprenticeship)

In light of the ongoing impact of COVID-19, we have reviewed all courses to build in additional flexibility to ensure learning and teaching can be delivered in a variety of circumstances during the Academic Year 2020/21. Please see below for information about how your course is being adapted.

In Academic Year 2020/21 your course will be delivered via a blend of learning and teaching which will take place on campus and through online platforms and materials. This means some of your classes will be timetabled and taught face-to-face in one of our teaching spaces but subject to carefully developed distancing and health and safety measures. The rest of your programme will be delivered online using virtual classrooms in Microsoft Teams, Moodle and other digital learning materials. In the event of further lockdown measures, all of your classes will be run online. However, when circumstances allow, we will aim to relax distancing measures and offer further teaching on campus.

Approach to teaching and learning in the Centre for Apprenticeships, Work-based Learning & Skills

Apprenticeships and Work Based Learning covers a diverse range of courses which already have a blended approach of learning and teaching embedded, including face-to-face workshops, online activities linked to the workplace, independent research, and tutorials; and you will continue to be supported by regular Progress Reviews with your tutor and employer. Any face-to-face workshops will be online where required, using Microsoft Teams, Moodle and standard LTU tools such as Panopto. Some workshops may continue to be held on campus, or other approved delivery locations, where capacity is in line with PHE and government guidance.
