## Children, Young People and Families Higher Apprenticeships

## **Children, Young People and Families Practitioner** (Level 4)

The Institute for Apprenticeships and Technical Education CYPF Practitioner Apprenticeship Standard offers 2 strands: Level 3 Residential Care and Level 4 Community routes. LTU will offer the Level 4 Community route, which incorporates a Certificate of Higher Education in Professional Practice in Working with Children, Young People and Families within the Community followed by an End-Point Assessment for the apprenticeship (i.e. the awards are not integrated).

All modules are 20 credits and will be available for delivery in semesters 1 and 2, dependent on cohort needs. A delivery timetable will be established for each cohort in negotiation with the employer(s).
