Such applicants may be asked to undertake an exercise to demonstrate knowledge of, and commitment to, the study of literature and spirituality.

Previous relevant work experience and learning will be assessed and, where appropriate, accredited as part of the application process. Please see the College's Assessment of Prior Learning (APL) procedures.

Candidates may choose, subject to approval by the Programme Director, to take up to 30 credits from option modules offered in the Leeds Trinity MA in Victorian Studies programme, and a further 15 or 30 credits from the respective extended option modules offered in the Leeds Trinity MA in Victorian Studies programme. One choice of module and extended module may be a free choice; the other must have strong relevance to Literature and Spirituality and be approved as an appropriate choice by the Programme Director.
