### **Progression and Award**

On entering the MA/PGDip programme, a student will be required to register directly for the MA.

A student may proceed to the PGDip or the MA having followed an approved Programme of Study for not less than one academic year and not more than four calendar years from the date of first registration upon the programme, and by passing prescribed assessments.

#### **Award of Master of Arts (MA)**

To be eligible for the award of MA in Journalism candidates must accumulate a total of 180 credits.

#### **Award of Postgraduate Diploma**

To be eligible for the award of the Postgraduate Diploma Candidates must accumulate a total of 120 credits.

Progression to MJO38011 is conditional on a satisfactory recommendation by designated tutor based on achievements in continuous assessment as demonstrated through the student's training record ("log book")

Successful completion of the PG Diploma is required for progression to the MA module.
