## **Progression and Award**

On entering the MA/PGDip programme, a student will be required to register directly for the MA.

# Award of Master of Arts (MA)

To be eligible for the award of MA in Journalism candidates must accumulate a total of 180 credits.

#### Award of Postgraduate Diploma

To be eligible for the award of the Postgraduate Diploma Candidates must accumulate a total of 120 credits.
