To be eligible for the award of MA, students must attempt and achieve 180 credits, which must include VIC7003 *The Victorians* and VIC7013 *Approaches and Methods for Victorian Studies*, and VIC7076 *Dissertation*.

All students failing VIC7003 must resit and pass the module before proceeding to their second year. Full-time students failing VIC7003 will therefore be required to change to part-time mode.

Candidates who fail a module twice will not be permitted to proceed on the MA programme but may be allowed to work towards a Postgraduate Diploma.

To be eligible for the award of the Postgraduate Diploma students must accumulate 120 credits, including 60 credits from the core modules.

To be eligible for a Postgraduate Certificate, students must accumulate 60 credits, including 30 credits from one of the core modules.
